A governing board that exercises good governance is an organisation's most valuable asset. Good governance is key to whether a non-profit organisation will be sustainable through good and bad times.

- **The governing board believes in and is committed to the organisation's mission and vision.**
- **The organisation complies with all legal requirements.**
- **The governing board has a plan in place to ensure the organisation's future sustainability.**
- **The governing board is actively engaged in and has accepted responsibility for the strategic direction, overall operation and financial oversight of the organisation.**
