Please join us in celebrating individual philanthropy by nominating a South African you think deserves recognition for their dedication and commitment to philanthropy!

Inyathelo – The South African Institute for Advancement works to actively promote philanthropy in South Africa. The Inyathelo Philanthropy Awards recognise and honour individuals who have shown outstanding leadership in the area of personal philanthropy in South Africa and who through their giving have contributed to sustainable social change and inspired others to give. The Inyathelo spotlight is not only on those who give large sums of money but also on those who demonstrate a philanthropic spirit through personal giving and who have exhibited a long-term commitment to and passion for bettering the lives of others.

There are five categories in which to nominate a philanthropist. Each category recognises someone who has combined passion, commitment and personal giving in order to support social causes.

Special Recognition Award for Philanthropy

This Award is in recognition of an individual philanthropist for his/her exceptional commitment to the advancement of philanthropy and their dedication to social giving to bring about beneficial change in South Africa.

Youth in Philanthropy Award

This Award is for a young person under the age of 35 who has pioneered creative ways of addressing development or social issues in his/her own community through direct financial support, development of charitable programmes, and the cultivation of a young generation of philanthropic leaders.

Women in Philanthropy Award

This Award recognises the contribution of an outstanding woman philanthropist for her leadership and innovation in growing awareness of philanthropy and who has, through her example, encouraged personal social giving in South Africa.

Community Philanthropy Award

This Award recognises an individual who has worked tirelessly to create a more positive and healthy environment in a particular community, giving of their personal money, their energy and their creativity to build initiatives and to encourage others to give.

Lifetime Achievement Award for Philanthropy

This Award pays tribute to individuals who during their lifetimes have tirelessly dedicated themselves and their financial resources to bring about social change, and to build a culture of giving in South Africa.

Nomination Criteria

1. The Inyathelo Philanthropy Awards recognise extraordinary individuals who have made innovative personal financial contributions to social development and who have demonstrated initiative and leadership in building philanthropy in South Africa.
2. "Individual philanthropy" is understood to mean "strategic personal financial giving for sustainable social development".
3. Individuals may be nominated who have, through their personal giving:
 - a. benefited an institution or organization in recognizable, identifiable, quantifiable and sustainable ways, and
 - b. shown innovation and leadership in philanthropy.
4. This impact, innovation and leadership can be demonstrated in the submission by providing information on:
 - a. projects supported by the philanthropist and what these projects have achieved;
 - b. the philanthropist's innovative ideas and initiatives that have resulted in quantifiable and sustainable social benefits; and
 - c. awards recognising projects that have been supported by the philanthropist.
5. Individuals (and couples or families) are eligible for nomination. Organisations and institutions are not eligible for these awards.
6. Nominations will be accepted from individuals and from organisations.
7. All submissions are reviewed according to set criteria by an Awards Review Panel, whose task it is to select from the submissions those nominees who best exemplify leadership and excellence in individual philanthropy in South Africa.
8. Nomination for an award does not automatically mean that the nominee will receive an award.
9. Nomination that do not receive an award in the year of their first nomination will be considered automatically for the following year.
10. Individuals must be South African or resident in South Africa.
11. Under no circumstances can Inyathelo consider nominations related to donations that may have been compromised by any kind of criminal activity.
12. To be considered for an Award, the nominee must be available in November 2010 to participate in the Inyathelo Philanthropy Awards 2010 event to be held in Cape Town.
13. For awardees, travel and accommodation expenses associated with attendance will be arranged and paid for by Inyathelo.
14. To be considered for an Award, a nominee must be willing to participate in any media coverage related to the Awards Programme.
15. A candidate may be nominated in one category only.
16. Nominators may submit a nomination in each of the five categories.
17. The Awards Review Panel reserves the right to move a nominee to another category if deemed more appropriate.
18. Do not include any documents that have not been requested as part of the nomination submission requirements.
19. Do not submit any original materials that are of value to you or your organisation. Submitted materials cannot be returned. **Any materials submitted in support of your nomination will become the property of Inyathelo and may be used in publicity materials.**
20. Only nomination forms that have been correctly and fully completed and submitted by the deadline will be considered.

Nomination Submission

Closing date for nominations: 12h00 on Friday 9 July 2010

To assist the panel members in their review of the nominees, please include the following:

1. A nomination letter of no more than 2 pages, briefly describing how the nominee meets each of the following eligibility criteria:
 - a. How has the nominee demonstrated innovation and leadership in philanthropy?
 - b. How is the nominee's philanthropic work sustainable?
 - c. How have the nominee's personal philanthropic contributions benefited your organisation/institution?

Please also include the following in the letter:

- a. A description of the financial support given, and the vision and leadership shown, by the nominee for sustainable social development
 - b. A description of the results that were achieved
 - c. A description of the impact the nominee had on the community, including numbers of people involved, organizations helped etc. Please include the names and contact information of individuals at the organisations who benefited from the nominee's work
 - d. A description of the long-term impact of the nominee's work
 - e. The nominee's current involvement in your organisation and/ or other projects
 - f. A description of the ways in which the nominee has inspired, challenged and assisted others in building South African philanthropy for sustainable social development.
2. A short resume of the nominee (not more than 2 pages).

In addition, you may also provide supplementary materials that support your nomination. This material could include, for example, photographs, newspaper articles, list of awards, video clips etc. Please bear in mind that these cannot be returned to you.
